

ORDINANCE NO. 6765

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AUBURN, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTIONS 3.10
AND 3.12 OF THE AUBURN CITY CODE RELATING TO
PUBLIC CONTRACTING AND PURCHASING

WHEREAS, after reviewing the City Code related to Public Contracting and Purchasing, it is appropriate to amend contract authorization limits consistent with Washington state law;

WHEREAS, City staff determined that Sections 3.10 and 3.12 of the Auburn City Code (“ACC”) require updates to the language used for consistency with the remainder of the ACC;

WHEREAS, City staff recommend consolidating subsections within former ACC 3.10.025 for clarity;

WHEREAS, ACC 3.10.028 is revised to update current City processes for capital projects;

WHEREAS, the emergency purchasing authorizations are modified for consistency with Chapters 39.04 and 38.52 RCW;

WHEREAS, it is also appropriate to amend the City Code to make it consistent with state law and reflect current City Council practices.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1. Amendment to City Code. Chapters 3.10 and 3.12 of the Auburn City Code are amended to read as shown in Exhibit A.

Section 2. Implementation. The Mayor is authorized to implement those administrative procedures necessary to carry out the directives of this legislation.

Section 3. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are declared to be separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or portion of this ordinance, or the invalidity of the application of it to any person or circumstance, will not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance, or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective date. This Ordinance will take effect and be in force five days from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
