

RESOLUTION NO. 5491

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF AUBURN AND AUBURN SCHOOL DISTRICT RELATED TO LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2019, the City of Auburn entered into an Agreement with Auburn School District No. 408 (School District) for School Resource Officer services to include three Auburn Police Department Officers to serve as school resource officers as well as a one-time contribution to the vehicle fleet; and

WHEREAS, the parties would like to amend the agreement to allow the School District to provide one-time compensation for the purchase of equipment designated for the School Resource Officer and that will become the property of the City of Auburn.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, WASHINGTON, RESOLVES as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement between the City and Auburn School District No. 408 relating to law enforcement services, which Amendment will be in substantial conformity with the Amendment attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to implement those administrative procedures necessary to carry out the directives of this legislation.

Section 3. This Resolution will take effect and be in full force on passage and signatures.
