ORDINANCE NO. 6856

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 10.36.268 OF THE AUBURN CITY CODE RELATED TO VEHICLE PARKING FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

WHEREAS, section 10.36.268 of the Auburn City Code (ACC) sets forth regulations and restrictions on vehicle parking for persons with disabilities, and in doing so adopts portions of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) by reference;

WHEREAS, since the City last updated ACC 10.36.268, its adopted RCW provisions have moved to elsewhere in the State code, leaving ACC 10.36.268 with incorrect State law references;

WHEREAS, ACC 10.36.268 is otherwise in need of revision to update its language for precision and clarity.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1. <u>Amendment to City Code.</u> Section 10.36.268 of the Auburn City Code is amended to read as set forth in Exhibit A to this Ordinance.

Section 2. Implementation. The Mayor is authorized to implement those administrative procedures necessary to carry out the directives of this legislation.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Severability.</u> The provisions of this ordinance are declared to be separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or portion of this ordinance, or the invalidity of the application of it to any person or circumstance, will not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance, or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective date. This Ordinance will take effect and be in force five days from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
