# What Is Emergency Management?

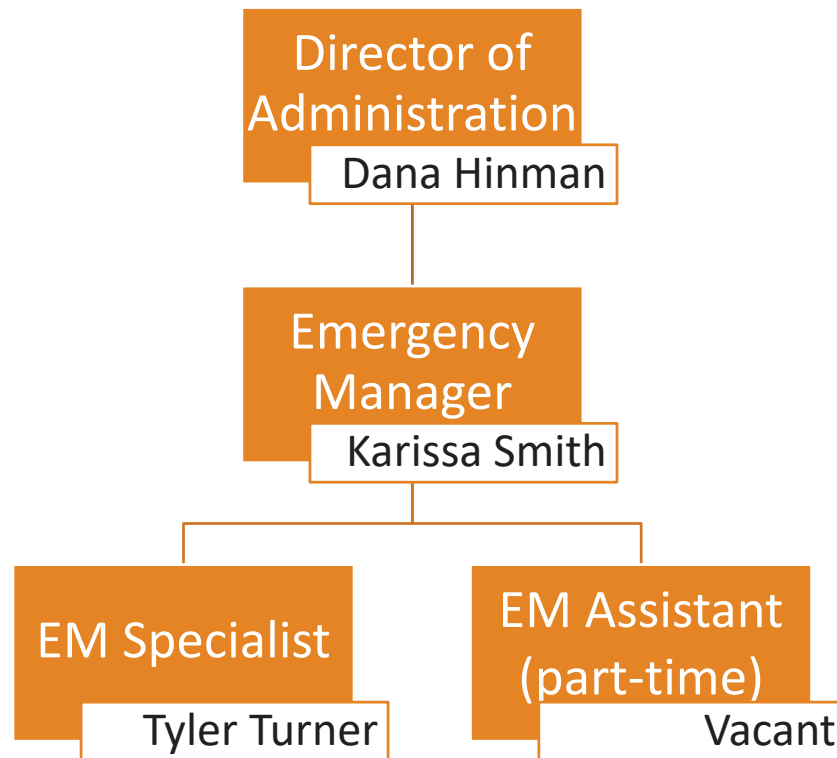
Coordinate the City's **response to** and **preparation for** incidents.

Incidents are emergencies or planned events that may go beyond the scope of normal local response capacity.

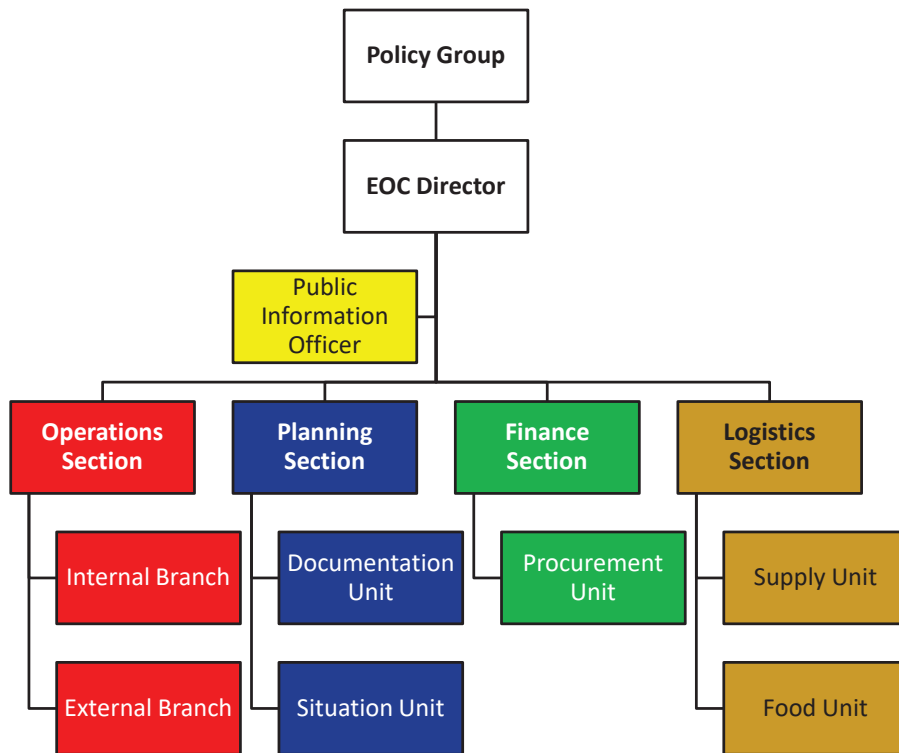

- Financial tracking
- Federal reimbursement

## **Communications**

- Alert and Warning
- Employee Notification
- Emergency Messaging
- PIO Support
- Radio (amateur radio, 1700 AM, 800 MHz public safety radio)

## **Operations**

- Coordinate with Departments
- Activate Emergency Support Function(s)
- Communicate with response partners

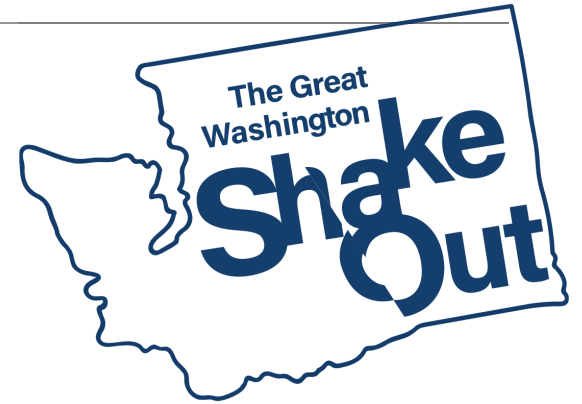
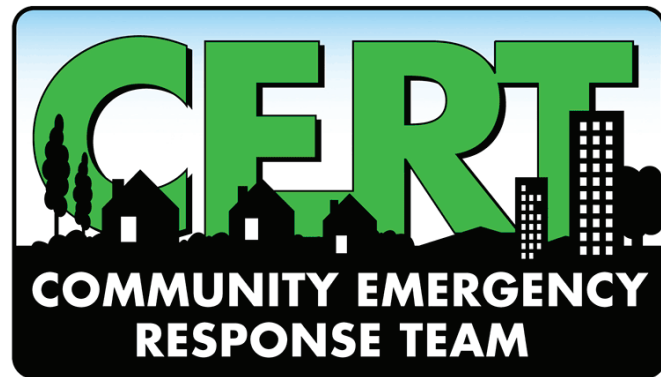

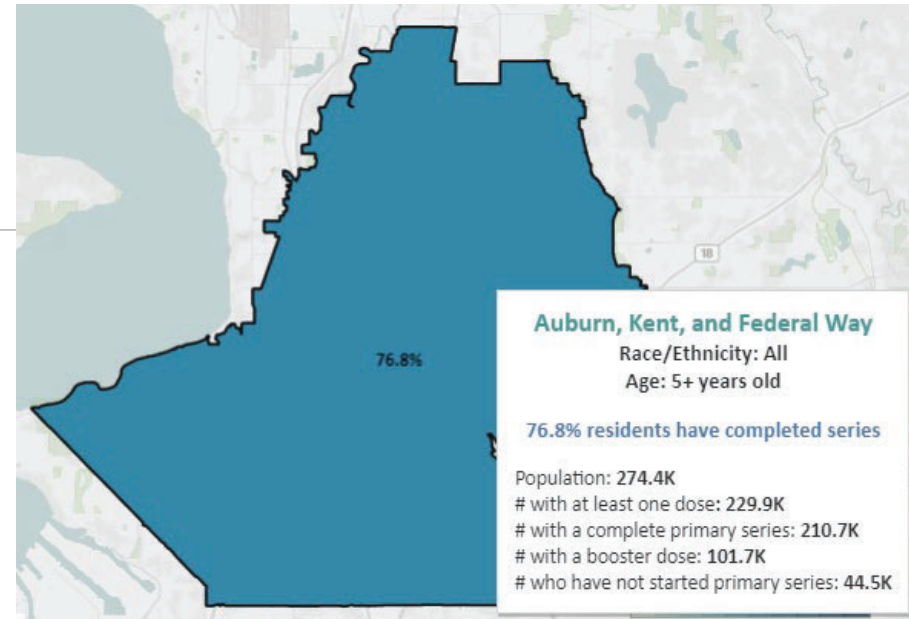
# COVID Update

76.8% of residents have completed primary vaccination

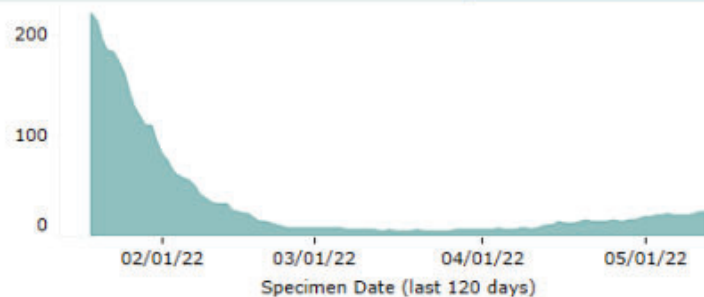


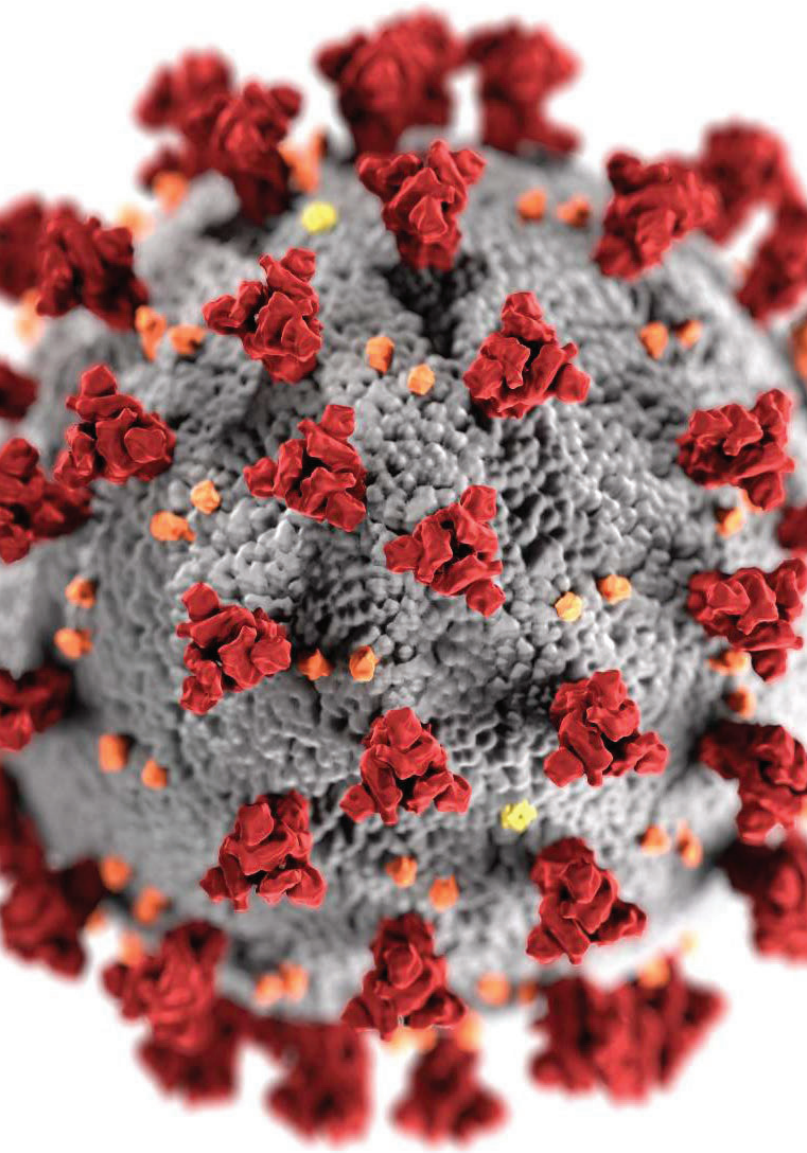
